

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION BUS RULES

- 1. Profane language is prohibited.
- 2. Seat belts, if provided, MUST be worn at all times until the bus comes to a complete stop at your destination.
- 3. Fighting, hitting and all other forms of undesirable physical contact are prohibited. Yelling or excessive noise is prohibited.
- 4. No eating or drinking on the bus.
- 5. Destruction of Barry County Transit property is prohibited.
- 6. Notification of unneeded transportation is required, when our records indicate two (2) "no show" trips for any student, we may suspend bus transportation privileges.
- 7. Always check your seat before exiting the bus for personal items. We are not responsible for items left on the bus.
- 8. Please call by 4:00 p.m. to make changes for the following day.
- 9. Student fare is \$1.00. Please have correct change each time you board the bus not when dropping off. We now have student "passes" which can be purchased in the Transit office or online for each month. We offer a 5% discount on all student "passes".
- 10. Please remember that the driver's first job is to safely transport your children to their destination. If the driver's attention is distracted, due to student behavior, they are unable to efficiently perform their main objective. We have authorized drivers to suspend bus privileges from any student violating the above rules after notification to the transit management.
